## REQUIREMENTS FOR COPYRIGHT REGISTRATION

- 1. The application form shall be accomplished in <u>DUPLICATE</u>, <u>TYPEWRITTEN</u> and the affidavit at the back should be duly <u>NOTARIZED</u>.
- 2. Application shall be accompanied by <u>TWO (2) COPIES OF THE WORK AS DEPOSIT</u>, (<u>Php. 200.00</u>) <u>TWO HUNDRED PESOS AS REGISTRATION FEE</u> and <u>2 PIECES FIFTEEN PESOS DOCUMENTARY STAMPS</u>. If sent through mail, the registration fee shall be in <u>postal money order (P.M.O.)</u> addressed to <u>THE DIRECTOR</u>, <u>NATIONAL LIBRARY OF THE PHILIPPINES</u>.
- 3. If the work applied for registration is an <u>original ornamental design</u> (classification H), it should be accompanied by a <u>TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION OF THE DESIGN</u>.
- 4. If the work applied for registration is <u>published work</u>, two (2) printed copies with copyright notice printed in front or at the back of the title page if it is a book and on any clear space thereof if non-book material, shall accompany the application. The <u>COPYRIGHT NOTICE</u> shall be in the form, <u>PHILIPPINE COPYRIGHT 20\_(YEAR OF PUBLICATION)</u>

  BY\_\_\_\_\_(NAME OF COPYRIGHT OWNER.)

  Sample format:

Philippine Copyright 2013 by National Book Store, Inc.

or

Karapatang Ari 2013 ni Juan C. Dela Cruz

No. 8 of the application should always be filled up by stating the specific date when the work is finished and likewise No. 9 be filled up to indicate when the work is published.

A <u>"published work"</u> for purposes of registration means that the work has been disseminated to the public prior to its registration with the Copyright Office.

- 5. If the work applied for registration is <u>unpublished work</u>, two (2) manuscript and/or Xerox copies of the work without the copyright notice shall accompany the application.
  - "Unpublished work" for purposes of registration means that the work has not been disseminated to the public at the time of registration.
- If the applicant is <u>non-resident foreigner</u>, he/she should appoint a local authorized agent by a <u>SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY</u> to prosecute copyright application for and his/her behalf with this office.
- If another person other than the author is claiming copyright ownership of the work, a
   <u>DULY NOTARIZED WAIVER OF COPYRIGHT OWNERSHIP</u> executed by the <u>AUTHOR</u> in favor
   of the person or legal entity making the claim should be attached to the application form.
- 8. If the applicant is a <u>PROPRIETORSHIP OR A CORPORATION</u>, a <u>PHOTOCOPY OF THE CERTIFICATE OF BUSINESS NAME (DTI or SEC Registration)</u> (first page only) should be attached to the application.
- 9. If copyright certificate/s will be sent through mail, the applicant must attached a **MAILING ENVELOPE** and the corresponding **MAILING STAMPS** to the filled-up application form.
