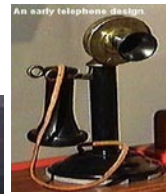




# Patent/ Invention



Before applying, you are advised to conduct a patent search to:

- Check if nobody has been issued or has filed a patent ahead of you.
- Know how a patent specification looks like because you will need to write one for your invention.

## Filing Requirements:

1. Fully accomplished request form (Triplicate Copies)
2. Specification or Description containing:
  - a. The Title
  - b. A brief statement of its nature and purposes
  - c. Brief explanation of the drawings, if any
  - d. Complete and detailed enabling description
  - e. Distinct and explicit claim or claims which the applicant seeks to be protected
  - f. Abstract of the invention

3. Drawings, if any. (Drawn on Bristol Board) Size: A4 = 29.7cm x 21cm

Imaginary margins	-	Top: 5.5cm	Left: 2.5cm
		Bottom: 1.0	Right: 1.5cm

4. Filing Fee:

### Small Entity: Asset P100M or Less

Php 2,020.00 maximum of 5 claims  
Claims in excess of five (5)  
= P190.00/claim

### Big Entity: Asset More than P100M

Php 4,363.20 maximum of 5 claims  
Claims in excess of five (5)  
= P370.00/claim

Request for Early Publication  
= Php 6,666.00
